

To expound the processes seen in this Library Managements System General Use Case, keep on reading!


This is the most common application of a use case diagram. The use case diagrams depict the system's main components as well as the flow of information between them.


As you can see the librarian or the actor could encode a certain book information. The system then will monitor its details to validate it ang then saves the data.


